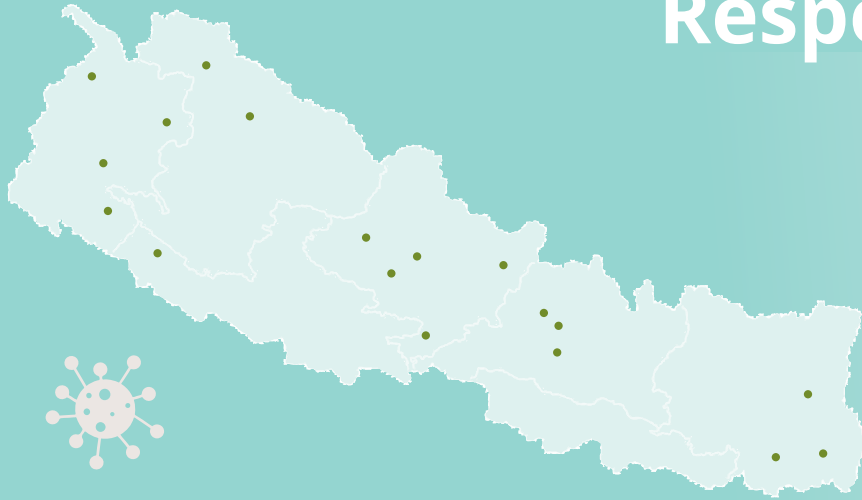
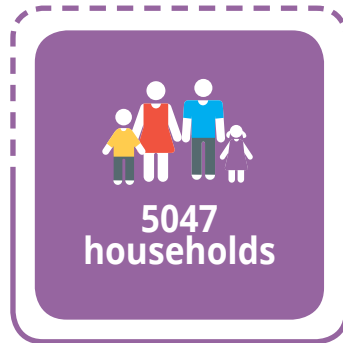


GNI Nepal's COVID-19 Response

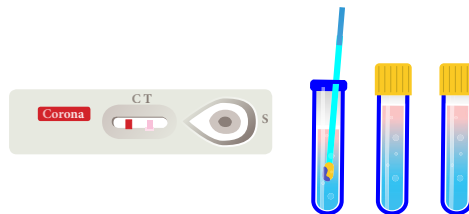


Medical & WASH Items



42,500 surgical masks

provided to Government of Nepal (2,000) and health institutions in Bajura (3800), Bardiya (7000), Darchula (5000), Doti (3000), Gorkha (6000), Humla (4500), Mugu (2000), Parbat (2000), Kaski (1500), Kathmandu (2200), Lalitpur (3300), and Nuwakot (1000) districts



10,080 RT-PCR kits, 10,100 RNA extraction kits and 10,100 VTM swab collection kits

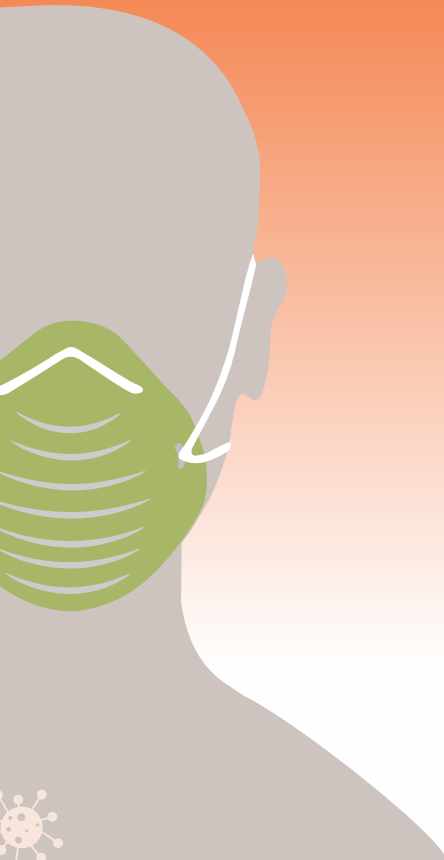


300 bottles of hand sanitizer, 2000 pairs of sterile gloves, 1200 goggles and 50 infrared thermometers

provided to Government of Nepal (1,200) and Tirsuli Hospital, Nuwakot (1,000)



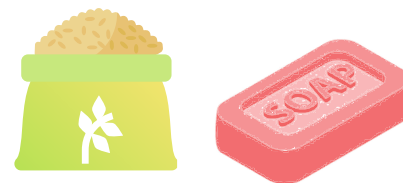
14 local government units
